

English Rules 2014

Welcome to the exciting world of nouns, verbs, sarcasm and puns! This year is going to be a great year and we are going to learn a lot together!

A few simple rules on how to keep your book neat and structured on the outside and the inside:

1. Your book must be covered in plastic with your name, grade and class, and teacher's name on it.
2. Number your pages in the top right hand corner of each page - tearing out of your English book for other subjects WILL NOT be tolerated.
3. At the beginning of each piece of new work, it must be set out as follows:

- s Rule off after each completed piece of work and begin the next piece of work directly underneath it. DO NOT leave pages open!
4. You **MAY NOT use Tippex** in your book, tests or exams. Neatly cross out your mistake and continue next to it.
5. Make sure that you have all the stationery you need - such as pens, pencils, scissors and glue. ALWAYS have a blue pen in your pencil case.
6. Your book will be taken in on a regular basis; ensure that all your work is up to date.
7. Make sure your handwriting is neat so that your teacher can understand you.


 Always have your English book at school when you have English on that day.

 Books being left behind or packing for the wrong day will not be acceptable excuses.

Class rules:


-  Always be on time for class.
-  When entering the class, wait quietly behind your desk for the teacher to greet the class and wait for an instruction to be seated.
-  Do NOT bother asking to be excused before the class has started and then do so at your own peril!


VERY important rules concerning absenteeism:

 Absenteeism is NOT an excuse for the following:

 Homework not done.

 Not being prepared for a test.

 Should you be absent, it is your responsibility to catch up with lost work BEFORE you return to your English class.

 Should you be absent during a test it is your responsibility to present a doctor's certificate on the day of your return AND write the test either in your first English period or the first available Academic Hour or Academic Detention.

 **Presenting a Doctor's note or letter from your parents is a NECESSITY!**
